

Mourne Motorcycle Club May Day motocross race

The Mourne Motorcycle Club will hold its annual May Day motocross race at the Seaforde Moto Park on Monday, May 4. The May Day race will also be the third round of the 2009 Irish Motocross Championship.

The Mourne club will run the event with the help of five sponsors:

French's and Noel Cochrane have helped riders before by supplying sponsorship, but this is the first time that they have helped the Mourne Motorcycle Club.
