SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Jurisdiction

The event will be held under the Motorcycle Racing Association (Ireland) Ltd Competition Rules and Standing Regulations including any supplementary regulations as have or may be issued for the event.

2. Eligibility

The event is open to riders competing on solo motorcycles and quads who are holding a current competition licence issued by the MRA and MCUI (SC), A.C.U. & Continental FMN's. Day licences will be available on the day.

6. Scrutineering of Machines and Signing on of Riders

Riders must present their machines, clothing and helmet in racing condition for checking. Scrutineering will take place in paddock from 8.30am to 10.00am. Crash helmets must bear the 2012 M.R.A. stamp. Each rider must have a current competition licence available for inspection when signing on, which is to be done before scrutineering. A rider must not race any machine not scrutineered. All machines to be placed in parc ferme after scrutineering. *Helmets must be worn if you ride your machine from scrutineering to startline.* Numbers will be provided for this event. No working lights are required. MX tyres are permitted. **USE OF TEAR OFFS NOT PERMITTED AT THIS EVENT.**

7. Exhaust Sound Level – FIM

Exhaust sound level test on ALL machines. The sound level must not exceed 96 dBa, as per method of sound control requirements and regulations. Machines will be tested after signing on. Machines that pass will be given a pass mark then submitted for scrutineering.

8. Riders Briefing

This will take place on the start line, 15 minutes before the race. The Clerk of Course will give the briefing.

9. Refuelling

THIS IS A NO SMOKING AREA! 10 mph speed limit in refuelling area. Engines must be switched off while refuelling; failure to comply will result in *exclusion*. **NO CHILDREN UNDER 16 YEARS OF AGE** allowed inside the pits and work area. There will be a number of fire points within the pit area, fire extinguishers are at these points.

10. Course

One lap measures 10 - 15 minutes approx consisting of rough going marked with rope, stakes and flags. Flag or marker cutting may entail exclusion, any rider leaving the course must return to it at the point at which he left it, penalty exclusion, except where it is inadvertent and no advantage is gained.

11. Start of a Race

The event is a dead engine start; riders will line up in their respective class, and will be let off by the drop of a flag by the start marshal.

12. Finish of a Race

Flag will go out at approx 1 ½ hour mark for Clubmen and approx 2 hour mark for Experts.

13. Awards

Top 3 in Clubmen; Top 3 in Experts.

14. Any rider refusing medical attention will not be allowed to race further on the day.

15. Please take ALL litter home; Thank You.

16. No dogs or any other animal will be permitted at this venue.

17. No pit bikes, scooters or bicycles will be permitted at the venue.
